Dear Parents and Guardians,

RE: Remote Learning

This afternoon, the Premier announced an increased level of restrictions (Stage 4) will apply to metropolitan Melbourne from 6pm tonight. Mitchell Shire is no longer linked to metropolitan Melbourne, as it has been since the start of Term 3, and will remain at Stage 3. These restrictions are expected to remain in force for the remainder of the term.

The Premier also announced that all Victorian schools will return to remote and flexible learning, for all students, from Wednesday, 5 August.

For our school, the announcement has the following implications:

- **Monday, 3 August**
 - Year 11 and 12 students attend normal classes at school
 - Years 3 to 10 attend classes online
- **Tuesday, 4 August**
 - student free day – no onsite or remote classes will be conducted
 - school prepares for transition to remote learning for all year levels
- **Wednesday, 5 August**
 - All students resume classes remotely...
 - Years 7 to 12 will follow their normal timetable, via SEQTA and Teams
 - Years 3 to 6 will continue with their established schedule

Supervision will continue to be offered to the children of essential workers.

An announcement will be made by the Premier tomorrow, regarding changes to work practices and additional restrictions. Should these restrictions limit our online provision, I will advise you of any changes.

I wish you all good health and thank you for your resilience and good will in these trying times. Hopefully, Term 4 may bring an easing of restrictions and a return to school. You are the parents of amazing children.
